Production and Distribution of Collateral

Travel Trade Directory

We have just finalised in the new 6th edition of the digital <u>Great West Way Travel Trade Directory</u>. This is the main resource being used by 116+ Official Tour Operators and has a targeted digital distribution via Great West Way and third-party databases of domestic and international key trade contacts. This Travel Trade Directory has received over 8,580 views online. We will be launching this new edition at Great West Way Marketplace in October, where there will be a few hard copies printed to distribute to those attending, plus it will be available as a digital page-turner on www.GreatWestWay.co.uk/traveltrade/travel-trade-directory

New Themed Suggested itineraries

We have developed some new suggested itineraries to help buyers develop new Great West Way programmes for 2025 and beyond. They include 'Follow in the Footsteps of Jane Austen'; 'A Delightful Detour to Oxford'; 'Explore Heritage Cities along the Great West Way'; and 'Glorious Gardens'. Digital Trade Communications

We have sent out trade enewsletters to buyers to promote Great West Way Marketplace this summer. The first one 'Book Now for Great West Way Marketplace' was distributed to 2,183 subscribers on 25 July 2024. It has received 38.1% open rate and 413% click through rate.

We also sent out another newsletter 'Book for Marketplace and New itineraries' on 5 September. This was distributed to 2,144 subscribers and received 41.8% open rate and 3.4% click through rate.

- <u>British Tourism & Travel Show</u>, NEC Birmingham, 19 & 20 March 2025. Domestic trade show for GTOs, coach and tour operators. We have a 4m x 2m stand booked with stand sharers confirmed as Bodleian Libraries, Stourhead and Blenheim Palaca. House of Britain campaign - Netherlands

We are working with one of our Official Tour Operators on a Dutch campaign where Great West Way and Ambassadors will be featured in <u>Great Britain magazine</u>. This subscription only travel magazine will be distributed in October to 17,500 Dutch consumers age 50+ and will also be sold in retail outlets. It is the only printed publication in the Netherlands promoting Great Britain. Thanks to all who have supported this.

House of Britain have also just launched some new Great West Way bookable programmes:

Great West Way is working in partnership with Cruise Britain to target the sector's shore excursion specialists and they have agreed to distribute Great West Way information to relevant members.

Great West Way Official Tour Operators

We now have 116 Official Tour Operators – who are committed to developing and distributing Great West Way programmes. Most recent sign ups include High Point Holidays – a UK based DMC working on a couple of new programmes with Evaneos – a French Tour Operator; and Rabbies, a UK based DMC with fixed programme departure points in London, Bristol and Bath.
