The central portion of the tour takes riders through chocolate-box villages nestled in the Chiltern Hills, and at the eastern end sit iconic attractions like Windsor Castle, Hampton Court Palace, and Kew Gardens. The Great West Way touches all of British history, from the Stone Age to the Second World War.
