About the Great West Way

Great West Way is the multi-modal touring route between London and Bristol, spanning some of England's most iconic heritage destinations and attractions. Based on ancient routes, the Great West Way encompasses 500 miles of navigable route on road, rail, water, footpath and cycleways through West London and the Thames Valley, Berkshire, Wiltshire, the Cotswolds, Bath and Bristol.

The route was established in 2017 with support from the UK Government's £40 million Discover England Fund, administered by VisitEngland. Managed by Great West Way Ltd, a not-for-profit Destination Management Organisation, the route is developed and promoted in partnership with

over 250 investing destinations and tourism businesses, working collaboratively as Great West Way Ambassadors.
